He edited *Memories of Sexual Betrayal: Truth, Fantasy, Repression, and Dissociation*, published by Jason Aronson in 1997, and he has recently written *Betrayed as Boys: Psychodynamic Treatment of Sexually Abused Men*, published by the Guilford Press in 1999. He currently serves on the Board of Directors of the National Organization on Male Sexual Victimization (NOMSV).

**Dr. David Lisak** is an associate professor of psychology at the University of Massachusetts Boston and a clinical psychologist with more than 15 years of experience working with male victims and perpetrators. In addition to his research and clinical practice, Dr. Lisak also consults widely on death penalty cases in which defendants have a history of childhood abuse, and participates in the training of judges on matters pertaining to sex offenders.
